# **TODAY AT ZION**

**MESSAGE**: An angry prophet. A fearsome and hated enemy. An overwhelming storm. And a surprising message of a merciful God to his people. The story of Jonah is one of the most well-known stories in the Bible. It is also one of the most misunderstood. Many people, even those who are not religious, are familiar with Jonah: a rebellious prophet who defies God and is swallowed by a whale. But there's much more to Jonah's story than most of us realize. As we continue our study of Jonah, we find our prophet confronted by both his own self-centeredness and the surprising righteousness of the pagans around him.

MISSIONS UPDATE: Geoff and Tammy Kooistra serve with HCJB in Quito, Ecuador where the country now has about 250,000 Venezuelan refugees, many of whom are well educated and had good jobs at one time. Various Christian ministries are working on relief as the government cannot handle such a large influx. Geoff is helping one ministry with logistics, food preparation, and kids' programs. He is asking for prayer for the refugee situation there and in many other parts of the world. In April HCJB hosted a well know Christian singer and pastor at a concert attended by about 3000 people. Geoff was in charge of transportation for the pastor and Tammy oversaw some of the logistics. The Kooistras will be with us next summer to share more about the ministry.
