Swimsuit & Swim Towel
Spending Money
Work gloves
Optional: Daypack (helpful if we will be working away from housing, also
going on many hikes)
Optional: Shower sandals
Optional: Sunglasses
Optional: Camera
Optional: Flashlight
Chargers/Portable Chargers
Optional: Sleep mask
Optional: Extension cord
