God prepared people for the coming of Christ at just the right time  1. "In the time of King Herod" – vs. 5  2. It was a time
3. God's timing scriptural promises - Genesis 3:15, Genesis 49:10
God used people to prepare others for the coming of Christ (vss. 5-13) John's parents —>John the Baptist —>Jesus
